I say this at the start to emphasize that I have no ulterior motives to my article (or person) selections and mean no disparagement by eithers absence. Just point me in the right direction and I'll do what I can to keep this list updated.

On that note, not all of the resources in this list are necessarily "good" sources and some have significant historical inaccuracies or debatable points (e.g. Lewis and Toland on Hypatia...) - but I have included them if they were something that I looked at or came across during my searches that provided an interesting / unique / "important" / perspective on the person/issue.

Lastly, I am purposely writing this for maximum accessibility to younger readers and I have purposely given the website timeline summaries a positive tone. I am not overlooking, denying, hiding, or otherwise obscuring the very real discrimination and sexism that nearly every woman described on this timeline directly faced.
